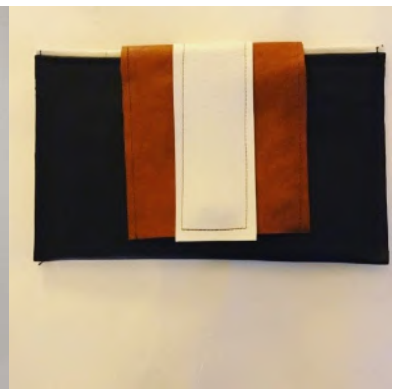

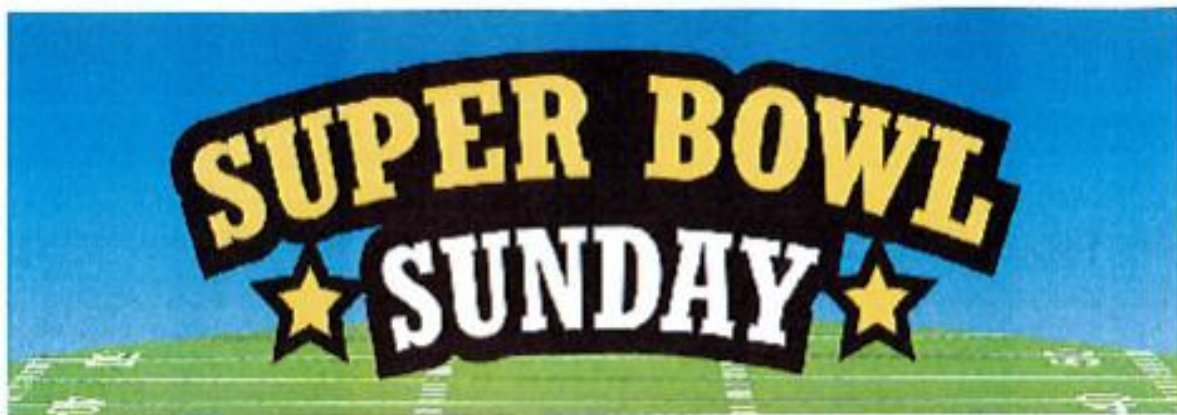

**Method 1:** Place a hold online or call to place a hold, come into the lobby during the above hours, ring the bell, and your items will be brought to you!

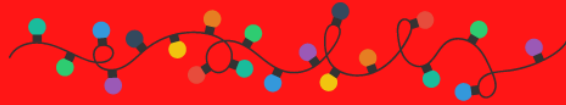
**Method 2:** Stop by the lobby any time during the above hours, ring the bell, and someone will get items for you/renew your card/get a new card/etc!

Our goal of keeping streets open, essential traffic moving and returning streets to travelable conditions quickly can only be accomplished with your help. This announcement has been prepared to make you aware of the City's Snow and Ice Plan and how you can achieve the plan's objectives. Working together, we will be able to provide the services of our winter maintenance program - KEEPING STREETS OPEN, ESSENTIAL TRAFFIC MOVING, AND RETURNING STREETS TO SAFE TRAVELABLE CONDITIONS QUICKLY. I hope you find this information helpful. Your support and cooperation is essential and appreciated.

### **Illegally Parked Vehicles**

Illegally parked vehicles are the biggest obstacle to effective snow removal efforts. Vehicles that violate the winter parking rules or otherwise hinder snow removal will be ticketed and towed at the owner's expense. Please support our efforts by parking your vehicle in conformance with the winter parking rules.

### **Snow Plowing**

The following is a general description of how the Department of Public Works plows snow on City streets:

**Step 1** - When a snow storm begins, the DPW responds by salting the main roads and travel routes. Salting these roadways serves two purposes: to keep traffic moving, and to prevent the snow from bonding to the pavement.

**Step 2** - Snow plowing begins when snow accumulates two (2) inches, or forecasts indicate it will. The City has four (4) trucks that can be called out and assigned to plow predetermined routes. The City's policy is to plow the full width of the street, curb to curb, after each storm.

**Step 3** - Once snowfall has stopped and plowing is winding down, salt trucks begin post-storm salting.

- Main streets and bus routes are salted to achieve bare pavement conditions.
- Residential streets with hills are treated to improve traction.
- Sidewalks must be cleared with a three (3) foot wide path for safe pedestrian travel at least once each calendar day.

- It is a violation of City Ordinance to deposit snow shoveled from pathways on any street or alley in the City.

Please cooperate so that school children and other pedestrians will be able to safely use the public walkways and avoid having to walk into the street.

## Driveways

While we try to minimize the amount of snow that gets plowed into driveways it is unavoidable. Clearing driveway openings is the responsibility of the property owner.

- Plow blades cannot be lifted as they pass by a driveway.
- Snow will be plowed into driveways as we perform curb-to-curb plowing.
- You may wish to clear your driveway several times during the storm or wait until the storm and plowing activities have ended.
- Shoveling, plowing or snow blowing snow back into the street when clearing driveways and sidewalks is prohibited by city ordinance.
- Hydrants: There are over 270 fire hydrants in Titusville. Please help us by shoveling around the hydrant near your home to aid in case of emergency. Questions and Concerns Contact Public Works: (814) 827-5300

# Emergycare Distance Learning Program to start in January

In September, Emergycare was awarded the federal Rural EMS Training Grant through the Department of Health and Human Services, Substance Abuse Mental Health Service Administration (SAMHSA) for the Northwest PA Rural EMS Training program. This grant was established in the Supporting and Improving Rural Emergency Services in Need (SIREN) Act of 2018. The purpose of the grant program is to recruit and train emergency medical services (EMS) personnel in rural areas.

The grant provided Emergycare with funds to purchase the technology needed to develop the necessary infrastructure for a quality distance learning program as well as additional EMS equipment to offer the classes simultaneously with classes being offered at the Emergycare headquarters in Erie, PA. In January, Emergycare will begin to offer Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) and Advanced Emergency Medical Technician (AEMT) Courses in Warren at Emergycare's Warren Division training center located at 12 South State Street, Warren, PA and in Meadville at EMMCO West located at 16271 Conneaut Lake Road #101 Meadville, PA 16335.

"Over the past few years, Emergycare has offered an EMT training program in Warren but had to cancel due to lack of the minimum number of participants. With this new technology, Emergycare is able to bring quality training to Warren and Meadville utilizing distance learning in a classroom setting with hands on lab instruction at all the site locations at a reasonable cost to the participant," said Jim Kifer, Education and Training Manager for Emergycare.

EMTs provide basic care out of hospital emergency medical care and transportation for critical and emergent patients who access the emergency medical services (EMS) system. To become certified students must successfully complete a state approved Emergency Medical

Technician (EMT) course. AEMTs provide basic and limited advanced emergency medical care and transportation for critical and emergent patients who access EMS. AEMTs perform interventions with the basic and advanced equipment typically found on an ambulance. For enrollment in the program current certification or licensure as an Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) is required. To become certified, students must successfully complete a state approved AEMT Course.

Emergycare sponsored courses for EMT and AEMT courses will begin in January 2021. EMT Class will run January 12, 2021 through April 29, 2021, T and TH from 6 to 10 p.m. and every other Saturday from 8 a.m.- 4 p.m. the Hybrid AEMT Class will run January 13, 2021 through April 7, 2021, M and W from 6- 10 p.m. and every other Saturday from 8 a.m. to 4p.m. To participate in the AEMT Class you must hold EMT certification. Upon completion of the AEMT program and successful certification as an AEMT, AEMT students will be eligible to enroll in a hybrid

Paramedic program that will run from late spring 2021 to December 2021. Registration will open at the end of November.

There will be no pre-registration as seating is limited and on a first come first serve basis. Registrations will only be accepted online at [www.emergycare.org](http://www.emergycare.org).
